

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

PAPERS should normally be composed of 8-10 pages – consisting of about 6,000 characters per page, including spaces

The text will be written with the Microsoft® Word program (version 6.0 or earlier), Times New Roman font, body 11, 12p interline:

- the cover page should contain: title, abstract and keywords (min 3, max 5) in Italian and English; the name and surname of the Author (or of the Authors) accompanied by qualification, affiliation, E-mail and the postal address of the Corresponding Author;
- the title with any subtitles will describe and delineate the subject concisely;
- the abstract should summarize the content of the manuscript, with particular reference to the results; it is recommended to take particular care of the English version of the title, abstract and keywords for facilitating the international dissemination;
- the various paragraphs (including Introductions and/or Premises and Conclusions) and the sub-paragraphs will have progressive numbering in Arabic numbers;
- the tables (word files) with synthetic titles will have a maximum 17.6 cm base and a progressive sequence with Roman numbering; the numerical values of the quantities will be rounded to the significant digit;
- the figures, accompanied by synthetic captions, will be in TIF or PDF format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi, a minimum base of 8.5 cm and they will be numbered with Arabic numerals; the diagrams will be accompanied by a clear indication of the quantities shown; readability will have to be verified at the printed scale;
- formulas will be composed with the Equation Editor (version 3.0)* and saved in .doc; numbered progressively with Arabic numerals in round brackets, aligned with the right margin; the magnitudes of dimensional quantities will be expressed in terms of units of the International System (S.I.); for the special symbols recalled in the text (eg φ β π λ etc.) the "Symbol" Font will be used;

* Alternatively, type the formulas in Times Roman body 10 and save them in a high resolution PDF.

- the notes will be numbered progressively;
- the bibliographic citations in the text will be in round brackets (Surname Author, 1994) and will be reported completely at the foot of the memory;
- in the bibliographic references the entries will be listed in alphabetical order, using a body 11, and structured with characters and punctuation marks as in the following examples:

Surname and Name of the Author or Authors, Year of publication. Title and subtitle of the work. Title Magazine and number, Publisher, Place of Publication, Number of pages.

e.g.:

Rossi F., 1999. *Protected Natural Areas*. Romana Editrice, Rome, p.254.

Rossi M., Verde R., Bianco N., 1980. *The Calabrian river*. L'Acqua 2, Ed. AII, Rome, pp.34-55.

- Bibliography: where applicable, the authors can prepare, if deemed useful, a systematic list of works, essays and articles pertinent to a specific scientist or topic.
